The recipient will accompany the ATHENA award winner to the International ATHENA Conference and become a member of the Chamber's ATHENA Committee.

- Protégé nominations must be received by the Chamber office by 5 p.m. on Friday, February 3, 2012.
- The ATHENA Protégé recipient will be announced at the March 2, 2012 Chamber Luncheon.

Protégé program applicants must:

- Demonstrate creativity, initiative and potential in their business or educational field.
- Devote time and energy to improve quality of life for others in the community.
- Be a female resident of Laramie County, age 21 to 35 at the time of nomination.

To apply, please provide the following items:

- A copy of a valid Wyoming driver's license.
- A brief one-page statement including:
 - how you help women reach their full leadership potential.
 - how you would benefit from a conference that focuses on women and leadership.
- A one-page resume.
- A letter of reference that speaks to your business achievements or potential.
- A letter of reference that speaks to your community involvement.

Interviews may be part of the selection process. The recipient of the Protégé Program award must agree to speak to the public about the program and the benefits of the conference. Call 638-3388 for more information.
