2007 PERSON OF THE YEAR AWARD

The following criteria will be used by a confidential panel of judges to select the recipient of the 2007 Person of the Year Award.

PURPOSE

The award is intended to honor a person who makes a substantial contribution to the Cheyenne area. As a result of the nominee's effort, the community should have received substantial benefits and become a better place to live and work.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

Nominees should be involved in the betterment of the community, through active civic participation. Their involvement may be in health or human services, education, recreation, arts or cultural improvement, economic development, or community-based organizations which contribute to the quality-of-life in our community. As a result of this involvement, nominees should have specific and noteworthy accomplishments.

COOPERATION AND SUPPORT

Nominees must have demonstrated willingness to assist in business and community projects by participating personally in projects or events that have resulted in substantial betterment of the community. Nominees must be members of the Greater Cheyenne Chamber of Commerce and may not be current members of the Board of Directors.

LEADERSHIP

Nominees must have exhibited leadership in community projects and have completed them successfully. Evidence of effective leadership in vital community projects and organizations will be considered. Nominees should be known and respected for their integrity.

Nominations will be accepted from anyone in the community. The deadline for nominations is Friday, January 11, 2008. All nominations must be submitted in a sealed envelope to Chamber President Dale Steenbergen. The Person of the Year Award recipient will be announced at the Chamber's Annual Banquet Friday, February 22, 2008, at the Holiday Inn. For further information, call 638-3388.
