

Business After Hours

As a BAH host, you business agrees to:

- Open your business to guests at no charge
- Provide the event venue from 5:00–7:00 PM
- Order and coordinate food and beverage
 - A non-alcoholic option is required
 - All caterers and beverage providers must hold the appropriate licenses
 - A list of potential caterers/providers is available upon request
- Actively promote the event through your own channels
- Engage your audience before and after the event to support attendance and follow-up
- Welcome attendees and facilitate connections during the event
- Organize giveaways, drawings, or prizes
- Manage and negotiate all co-sponsorships
 - A restaurant, caterer, or beverage vendor may co-sponsor the event

The Chamber agrees to:

- Create and manage the event listing and promotional
- Design official Chamber-branded event content
- Promote the event through Chamber communication channels
- Coordinate event logistics with the host
- Provide on-site Chamber staff support
- Recognize approved co-sponsors in event advertising

Important Note: Strong attendance and meaningful engagement at these events requires active promotion and audience engagement by the host business prior to, during, and after the event.

If you would like to host a Business After Hours, you must complete the application located on our website under Member Resources and submit it for approval. (www.cheyennechamber.org/member)

If your application is approved, payment is due within 30 days of approval. If payment is not received within that timeframe, the Chamber will not hold the event date.

Voluntary Support Fees
