Business After Hours

The Chamber will:

- Host one event per month, on the first or third Thursday. (Special events may fall on another day of the week based on availability.)
 - BAH happens from 5:00 7:00 p.m.
 - (Special events may occur at another time based on availability.)
- Develop an advertisement* for the event.
- Execute advertising on various platforms including:
 - Social Media
 - Newsletters
 - Community Calendar
- Chamber staff will attend, take photos, and promote the event
- Chamber staff are available to provide support in the planning of BAH at the level requested by the Host.

The Host will:

- Open their business up to guests at no charge
- Be responsible for ordering food and beverage.
 - o A non-alcoholic option is required
 - A list of potential caterers is available upon request.
- A restaurant, caterer, or beverage vendor may co-sponsor the event.
 - Negotiations for co-sponsors are the responsibility of the Host
 - All co-sponsors may be recognized in advertising
 - The Host must notify the Chamber of all Co-sponsors before advertising is finalized.
- Ensure event caterer has correct liquor license
 - Chamber team can provide a list of licensed caterers upon request
- Organize giveaways, drawings, or prizes
 - The Host must notify the Chamber of giveaways before advertising is finalized
- Pay the Chamber a Business After Hours/Special Event fees within 30 days of the signed contract and/or confirmed email.
